Honorary Colonel of Regiment Visits 1-30 IN and 2-30 IN

In October, Honorary Colonel of the 30th Infantry Regiment, General Barry McCaffrey, USA (Ret.) visited Fort Stewart, GA at the invitation of 1-30th Commander, LTC Dan Cormier. General McCaffrey met with 3rd ID (Mechanized) Commanding General, MG Anthony Cucolo; had seminars with Company Officers and Sergeants; talked to 1100 troops; and presented a seminar on "Combat Leadership" to Brigade Field Grade Officers. General McCaffrey's timely visit preceded the 1-30th's deployment to Iraq.

In November, General McCaffrey was invited by 2-30th Commander, LTC Chris Ramsey to visit Fort Polk, LA prior to the brigade's deployment to Afghanistan. During his visit, General McCaffrey met with Joint Readiness Training Center and Fort Polk Commanding General, BG James Yarbrough, gave an update on the situation in Afghanistan to Battalion and Company Commanders, and participated in the 2-30th's Organization Day with soldiers and their families.

General McCaffrey currently serves as an adjunct pro-

fessor of international affairs at West Point. He previously served as U.S. drug czar from 1996 to 2001 and prior to that as Commander, United States Southern Command from 1994 to 1996. He served four combat tours and was wounded in action three times.

General McCaffrey takes pride in being Honorary Colonel of the 30th Infantry Regiment, and is proud to support 3ID, 1-30 IN and *The Watch on the Rhine*.
